

Seminar on Economic Development at Alyeska Resort

There will be a seminar on Economic Development to be held at the Alyeska Resort from October 23-25, 1972. This 3-day seminar is sanctioned by the American Industrial Development Council, the international professional organization of economic developers. The emphasis of the seminar is to provide fundamental knowledge concerning the potential and rational economic development activities within the state of Alaska.

A major focus will be placed

on the basics of world community involvement, governmental programs, and environmental awareness to management. Included in the program, along with other distinguished speakers, are Richard Preston, executive vice-president of the American Industrial Development Council, whose presentation will be an overview of economic development; Harry Carter, executive director of Alaska Federation of Natives, on the economic development potential of the Alaska Native Land Claims Settlement Act; Dr. Arlon Tussing, staff economist, Senate Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs; Dr. A.R. Mandour, School of Business, University of New Haven; and David L. Egan, vice-president, American Express Asset Management Company.

The seminar is open to all interested parties. The fee of \$150 covers all costs: instruction and materials as well as room and meals at Alyeska for

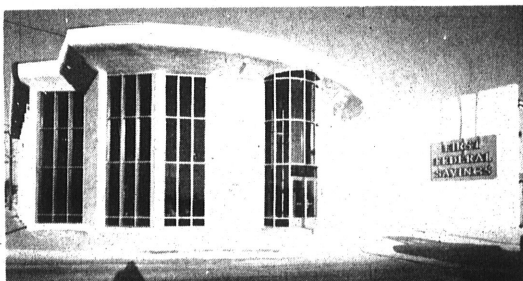
