

280 Officers and Men—

Ships to Chart Alaska Waters

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Congressman Nick Begich said four U.S. government ships—manned by approximately 280 officers and crew—and an aerial photo

plane will chart Alaskan waters this year in a long-range program to provide detailed, up-to-date information for the state's increased marine activities and economic development.

The program will be conducted by the Commerce Department's National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration. The data will be gathered for 23 new charts for use by fishing and deep-draft cargo vessels. Some of the areas have not been surveyed in over 50 years.

Representative Begich explained that hydrographic survey ships DAVIDSON, PATHFINDER, RAINIER, and FAIRWEATHER, operated by NOAA's National Ocean Survey, will perform this year's task.

The surveying ships, which will spend about five months in Alaska, will work in Cook Inlet, the Gulf of Alaska and Clarence, Keku, Sumner and Shelikof Straits. These waterways include the ports of Ketchikan and Anchorage.

Ship operating schedules and the ports they plan to put into

follow:

—DAVIDSON: Keku and Sumner Straits, Southeast Alaska, April through September. Ketchikan and Wrangell.

—PATHFINDER: Clarence Strait, Southeast Alaska, April through May. Cook Inlet, May through September. Ketchikan, April 17, and Kodiak, May 28.

—RAINIER: Shelikof Strait, April through August. Kodiak, April 4.

—FAIRWEATHER: Cape St. Elias waters, April through August. Cordova, April 14, and Kodiak, May 29.

Gets New Hotel

The Stikine Inn, a new two-story chalet-type hotel, opened its doors officially on February 19, giving the Southeastern Alaskan community a second accommodation facility.

Commissioner Irene Ryan of the Alaska Department of Economic Development reported that the Stikine Inn was partially funded through the Alaska Small Business Development Corporation.

The new hotel has accommodations for up to 32 people in 16 rooms and includes a fireplace-equipped ballroom, a full dining room and a complete cocktail lounge.

The main floor is decorated with a nautical flavor, while the individual guest rooms offer Mediterranean decor.

Rates for the new Stikine Inn start at \$16 for a single and top out at \$28. Located in the center of Wrangell, the Inn is accessible to all local services and is expected to become a prime facility for small conventions.

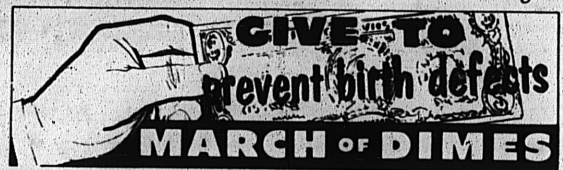
