Sealed bids in single copy for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment, and performing all work on Project BR-0999(10) and RS-0999(11), Skagway River Bridge and Approaches described herein, will be received until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time, November 15, 1973 in the Commissioner's Office, Department of Highways, Island Center Building, Douglas, Alaska.

This project will consist of grading of 0.18 miles of roadway and construction of a 482 foot composite steel girder bridge, with a 28 foot roadway width, over the Skagway River.
Principal items of work consist of the following: 6,012 cubic yards unclassified excavation; 989 cubic yards subbase, grading D; 375 linear feet beam type guardrail; 710 cubic yards riprap, Class II; oil lines relocation, all required; removal of structures and obstructions, all required; class A concrete, all required (approx. 62.2 cu. yds.); class A-A concrete, all required (approx. 340.8 cu. yds.); reinforcing steel, all required (approx. 82,890 lbs.); structural steel, all required (approx. 411,120 lbs.); 4,284 each stud shear connectors; 1,402 linear feet structural steel piles; and 990 linear feet metal bridge railing.

All work shall be completed in 245 Calendar days.
