Applicant: Eskimos, Inc., P.O. Box 536, Barrow, Alaska 99723

The Wainwright Activity: Fuel Services Tank Farm is operated by Eskimos, Inc. The operations are conducted in the State of Alaska and involve supplying diesel and unleaded gasoline in Wainwright. To support their operations they operate bulk fuel storage tanks whose capacity exceeds 42,000 gations. Facilities of this type are potential sources of large fuel spills. To prevent or minimize the possibility of a discharge and to ensure that the facility is capable of cleaning up a fuel spill should one occur, the facility is required to have an Oil **Discharge** Prevention and Contingency Plan.
