

CITC offers aid for low-income renters, owners

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program is accepting applications from renters or homeowners in need of assistance, according to the Cook Inlet Tribal Council.

LIHEAP provides assistance to low-income Alaska Natives and American Indian households.

A monthly energy subsidy is available along with crisis assistance and emergency fuel.

Eligibility is based on an income test or categorical eligibility — people already qualifying for Aid to Families with Dependent Children, Supplemental Social Security Income or Food Stamps.

Administered by CITC, LIHEAP serves Anchorage, Mat-Su, Eklutna, Knik, Kenai, Ninilchik, Seldovia and Tyonek.
