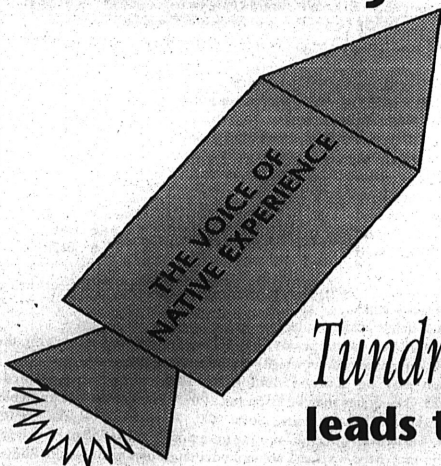
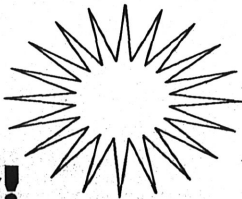
The Alaska District invites your comments on the proposed action and any information you want to be considered before we prepare the environmental assessment (EA) for the project.

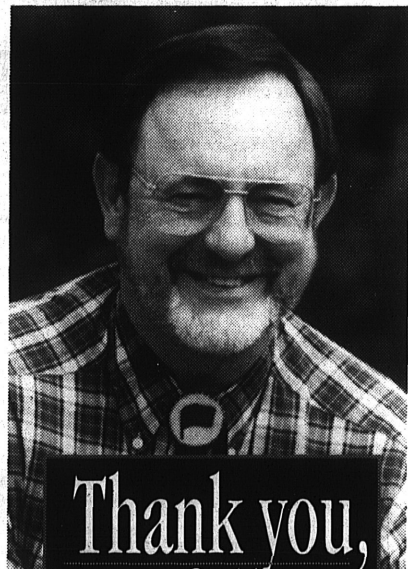
