SJC provost resigns

Sheldon Jackson College lost its provost last week when Dr. Mary Lou Madden resigned from the position.

Madden served as Provost of the College for over two years. She said she was leaving to pursue other career options.

"Mary Lou Madden has made significant and enduring improvements in the administration of Sheldon Jackson College," said John W. Sweetland, Chairperson of the College Board of Trustees, in a written statement.

"Not only did she lead the college through its recent successful accreditation review, but she also instituted many new policies and changes at an administrative level that have significantly strengthened the institution."

SJC's President, Dr. Kenneth Cameron, said the school will begin an immediate search for a senior academic administrator to replace Madden.
