

Native corporations hire top brass

Two Alaska Native corporations hired top officers recently.

Klukwan, Inc. elected Albert Rinehart as Chairman of the Board and Chugach Alaska Corporation appointed Michael F. G. Williams chief operating officer of the corporation. Chugach also hired three other new executives.

Rinehart is completing his first three-year term on the Board of Directors of Klukwan, a Native corporation headquartered in Juneau. Rinehart was elected to the post at the annual shareholders meeting June 22.
