

TKC hunting permit program changes

The Kuskokwim Corporation is continuing the permit program for non-shareholders using its land that it began four years ago. Last year, the cost of that permit increased to \$400 for big game hunters. The fee for a recreational permit for non-hunters is \$100. This year, The Kuskokwim Corporation has hired a security company, Purcell Services Ltd., to patrol TKC land along the Kuskokwim River from September 1 to Sep-

tember 21.

Land Use Permits must be paid for in full prior to going on Kuskokwim Corporation land. Permits can be purchased from the offices of the corporation in Aniak or Anchorage, at Red Devil Hardware or Mercury Inn in Red Devil, and M & M Store in Sleetmute. The river monitors will also have some available for sale.

For 1993, all non-shareholders are required to buy a Land Use

Permit for \$400 if they want to hunt on TKC lands. For non-shareholders who have resided within the region for the last five years, the fee drops to \$100. Shareholders and their direct descendants (children or grandchildren) do not need a permit.
