

Grants writing workshop set

Space is still available to enroll in the 5-day Grants Writing Workshop hosted by Arts Alaska, Inc., February 22 through the 26th, in Anchorage.

Offered by the Grantsmanship Center of Los Angeles, the Grantsmanship training program focuses on training public and private non-profit agencies to effectively compete for government, corporate and foundation grants.

This intensive week-long workshop concentrates on basic planning and proposal writing skills, and on establishing a clear understanding of the ins-and-outs of obtaining grants. Participants will be

able to write and review their own grant proposals while working extensively with reference materials and identification of funding sources.

The Grantsmanship Center, a non-profit educational institution, has trained more than 1600 staff of public and private agencies over the past nine years. Participants have ranged from the smallest non-profit agencies to the largest public institutions.
