Ski races to draw 130 competitors

ANCHORAGE — The ARCO Cup-Alaska Divisional Alpine Championships, set for February 19-21 at Alyeska Ski Resort, are expected to draw 130 competitors between the ages of 11 and 45.

The races are sponsored by ARCO Alaska, Inc., and conducted by the Alyeska Ski Club. Rotating trophies will be presented to the male and female skiers who rank first in combined times for the three race events.

Downhill competition is set for Friday, February 19, with giant slalom races on Saturday, February 20, and slalom races on Sunday, February 21.

All races will begin at 10:30 a.m., according to Sally Gibbs, chief of race.

Skiers taking part in the Alaska divisional championships will be qualifying for the Junior Olympics and the U.S. National Championships later this year.
