Sealed bids in single copy for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment, and performing all work on Project No. K-31155 Pelican Harbor Improvements, described herein, will be received until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time, March 4, 1982, in the Second Floor Conference Room at 6860 Glacier Highway, in Juneau, Alaska. This project will consist of the following major work items:

- (1) Construct one 12 foot x 69 foot timber approach and two 3 foot x 34 foot timber service walkways.
- (2) Construct one 18 foot x 80 foot steel grid. (3) Dredge approximately 35,903 cubic yards of material to expand existing basin.
- (4) Place approximately 2,182 cubic yards of rock slope protection.

All work shall be completed by November 30, 1982.

The following provisions are made a part of all advertisements for Harbor construction contracts:

"Bidders must submit certifications stating whether or not they intend to subcontract a portion of the work and, if so, that they have taken affirmative action to seek out and consider minority business enterprises as potential subcontractors. Each bidder intending to submit part of the contract work shall make contact with potential minority business enterprises subcontractors to affirmatively solicit their interest, capability, and prices, and shall document the results of such contacts. A bidder's failure to submit this certification or submission of a false certification shall render his bid nonresponsive."
