

UA Announces Industrial Development Course

Mr. Richard Eakins, Director of the Division of Economic Enterprise, announced the formulation of a Basic Industrial Development Course to be given in Fairbanks at the University of Alaska, from September 16 - 21, 1973.

The industrial course is the first in Alaska accredited by the

American Industrial Development Council, and the lectures will focus on industrial and economic development techniques which are applicable to the Alaska situation.

The course will be open to industrial developers within the regional corporations and to

community development specialists on the staff of municipalities throughout Alaska.

Close cooperation between the Division of Economic Enterprise, the University of Alaska, the Rural Alaska Community Action Program and the Community Enterprise Development Corporation will insure a pro-

gram germane to Alaska developmental problems.

Participants successfully completing the course will be eligible for enrollment in the Industrial Development Institute given at Norman, Oklahoma, the only sanctioned advanced industrial training course in North America.
