## Management Training Prog. is Scheduled at Barrow

FAIRBANKS — A management training program sponsored by the University of Alaska will be held in Barrow from Feb. 18-23

The program was designed especially for North Slope Borough employees and personnel of the regional corporations set up under the Native Land Claims Settlement Act. However, according to Dr. Mildred Matthews, other interested persons are welcome to attend.

Matthews helped set up the program. She is coordinator of tourism, business and adult vocational training for the university's Division of Statewide Services on the Fairbanks campus.

The Barrow coordinator of the management training program is David Fauske, a U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs employee in Barrow and the University of Alaska representative there.

Dr. Earl Peterson, business manager for the university's Northern Region, and Jeff J. Cook, an associate of the Earl E. Cook Real Estate firm of Fairbanks, will participate in the program.

Peterson will speak on such topics as planning and organizing, records, the language of business, profits and personnel.

Cook will instruct in real estate management, including land, structures, appraisal and assessment. He will also give information on legality, return on investment, taxes and hotel development.
