

Legislature Could Become Unicameral

Similar resolutions proposing that the Alaska State Legislature become a unicameral body are presently under consideration in the House Judiciary Committee and the Senate State Affairs Committee.

Should either version of this legislation pass both houses, the question, in the form of a constitutional amendment, would be put to the voters in the next statewide election.

The House Judiciary Committee is seeking public input concerning the possibility of creating a unicameral legislature. A public hearing has been scheduled for Feb. 20, 1975 at 1:30 p.m. in Room 100 of the Capitol Building in Juneau.
