

# Board Seeks Ideas on Pupil Standards

Recognizing this, the State Board of Education has scheduled a series of public hearings and teleconferences on the proposed student performance standards for English/language arts, mathematics, and science. The Board invites all Alaskans to submit written comments or testify at one of the hearings listed below.

In addition to the face-to-face hearings listed here, the Board is offering teleconference hearings to dozens of other communities with Legislative Information Offices (LIO) or volunteer teleconference sites. Please contact your nearest LIO or the Department of Education for details.

The Board may take action to adopt these student performance standards as regulations at its February 16-18, 1994, meeting.
