

Klawock gets 1st in tournament

Klawock took the Division III first place in state competition recently, with a 42-24 win over Port Lions, which took second place.

Noatak won 75-37 over Shishmaref, to finish third place, and Shishmaref won fifth place.

The Chevak Girls Basketball team made their second trip in three years to the State Basketball Tournament and took fourth place in the state competition. The team won over Kalskag, 47-39, and Kalskag took sixth place in the tournament.

Winning the Division III Tournament held in Kasigluk with a 70-57 victory over Kasigluk in the finals enabled the Chevak Comets to advance to state competition.

Mary-Ann Francis, sophomore, was elected to the Division III all-star team. And Tillie Peter, junior, was named to the State All-Star Team.

In state competition, the Comets defeated Kipnuk in the preliminary round by a score of 74-37.

Playing the same day, the Comets met up with a tough Noatak girls squad and suffered a close 49-47 loss.

Once placed in the losers bracket, the Comets defeated Anakutvuk Pass, 56-52, and Kalskag to claim fourth place.

The Comets finished the year with a 13-3 record. Their only losses came from Toksook Bay, Bethel Varsity and Noatak.
