The Older Alaskans Commission announces the availability of funds for the SENIOR COMMUNITY SERVICE EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM (SCSEP) consisting of subsidized training and employment positions for economically disadvantaged persons fifty-five years of age and older.

SCSEP training and employment positions must contribute to the general welfare of the community. Priority is given to positions which provide training and/or work experience that will lead to documented available employment within the grant year.

SCSEP positions may not result in the displacement of currently employed persons. Funds will be available for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1987 and ending June 30, 1988. Eligible applicants include public and private non-profit agencies and units of local government. Grant applications must be postmarked no later than April 15, 1987.
