



UBA breaks ground for new building

United Bank of Alaska Chairman Willie Hensley and UBA president Eugene Erskine break ground for a four-floor, 30,000-square-foot branch bank building in Anchorage. UBA is owned by Bristol Bay, NANA, Cook Inlet Region, Doyon Ltd., Sealaska, Chugach Natives, Inc., and Ahtna Regional Corporations, and the Kikiktagruk Inupiat Corp., the Native Village Corp. of Kotzebue. The building, being constructed by Hoffman Construction, should be ready for occupancy in mid-1983.
