

JOM certifying Native children

The Cook Inlet Native Association Johnson O'Malley Program is in the process of certifying all eligible Alaska Native and/or American Indian students of 1/4 or more Native blood between the ages of 3-years-old and graduating high school seniors in the Anchorage area school district.

Certification forms must be completed by the parents or guardians and be received by Thursday, Sept. 30, 1982.

The budget of the Johnson O'Malley Program is based on the enrollment of all eligible students, so please complete the forms as soon as possible.
