

KCC First Building Bid Rejected But Is Being Redesigned

FAIRBANKS — The single bid received for construction of Kuskokwim Community College's first building has been rejected because it exceeded funds available for the work, but the project is not being put on the shelf. The University of Alaska's Office of Planning and Institutional Studies is now redesigning the building to bring down its cost and will seek new bids in the fall. Anchorage submitted a base bid of \$425,853 on the college building, to be constructed at Bethel. The 1972 university bond issue approved by voters included \$1 million for extension centers, and the university's Board of Regents allocated \$350,000 of this amount for the KCC building.
