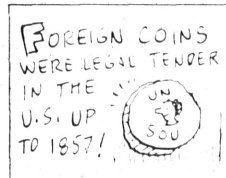

INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed bids, in simple copy for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment, and performing all work on Project RF-0711(24), Richardson Highway, Keystone Tunnel Grouting described herein, will be received until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time, February 14, 1973 in the Commissioner's Office, Department of Highways, Island Center Building, Douglas, Alaska.

This project will consist of providing a chemical grouting project at the Keystone Tunnel to stop or reduce seepage into the tunnel and to stabilize and consolidate the chimney at the north end of the tunnel.

The tunnel is located at mile 16 on the Richardson Highway. Items of work consist of the following: mobilization, lump sum, all required; 130,000 pounds of chemical grout; 1,150 grout holes; maintenance of traffic; contingent sum, all required; and timber cribbing, removal and replacement, contingent sum, all required.

Prequalification of the Grouting Engineer will be a requirement on this project, as further specified in the "Instructions to Bidders."

All work shall be completed in 70 calendar days.

Plans and specifications may be obtained by all who have a bona fide need for them for bidding purposes from the Chief Design Engineer, P.O. Box 1467, Juneau, Alaska at a charge of \$10.00 for each assembly. Plans may be examined at Department of Highway Offices in Anchorage, Fairbanks, Valdez.
