Project Name: Russian Mission Airport Lighting

Description of Work: The project consists of lighting the runway at the Russian Mission Airport, the installation of the electrical equipment in the equipment storage building, and miscellaneous electrical items.

Principal Quantities of Work: Mobilization and Demobilization, One Job; Reflective Markers, 64 Each; Constant Current Regulator, 1 Each; Medium Intensity Runway Lights, 40 Each; Medium Intensity Taxiway Lights, 14 Each; Handholes, 7 Each; 2" Fiberglass-Reinforced Epoxy Conduit, 1,560 Linear Feet; 2" PVC conduit, 5,750 Linear Feet; No.8 5KV Cable, 6,856 Linear Feet; No.6 Bare Copper Ground, 6,961 Linear Feet; No. 1/0 600 volt KHHW Cable, 3,050 Linear Feet; Ground Rod, 9 Each; Lighted Wind Cone, 1 Each; other necessary items of work.

The Engineer's Estimate is between \$100,000 and \$250,000. All work shall be completed by July 1, 1984.

Bidders must submit certifications stating whether or not they intend to subcontract a portion of the work and, if so, that they have taken affirmative action to seek out and consider minority business enterprises as potential subcontractors. Each bidder intending to subcontract part of the contract work shall make contact with potential minority business enterprise subcontractors to affirmatively solicit their interest, capability and prices. Kotlik Traditional Council will receive sealed bids for the purchase and delivery of lumber, nails, cable and cable clamps to Kotlik, Alaska until 3:00 p.m. prevailing time April 8, 1983 at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. The estimated need is for 181,008 bd. ft. of 2" x 6" treated lumber, of which 35,008 bd. ft. must be 8' lengths. The remaining 146,000 bd. ft. of lumber can be 12' long, however, the Grantee reserves the right to negotiate the lengths per unit price to reduce cost. 83-50 lbs/cartons of 20d nails are required with the bid. Also needed are 500' of 3/8" cable and approximately 150 cable clamps. The entire bid package must cover shipping and handling charges delivered to Kotlik, Alaska 99620.
