

Calista starts Bethel project

Calista Construction Company, vice-president and general manager, Chuck McClain, has announced that the construction company, a Calista Corporation subsidiary, is breaking ground for a \$6 million, 47-unit apartment complex in Bethel.

The complex will be a 45,000 square foot, two-story wood framed structure, and will be located adjacent to the Bethel Hospital.

Comprised of 80 modular units, the housing complex will provide housing for the Alaska Area Native Health Service,

Bethel hospital employees.

The units are being pre-fabricated by Boise Co., of Boise, Idaho, and will be shipped from Seattle to Bethel in June and August 1983.

All onsite construction will be performed by Calista Construction.
