

Improvements planned for SW Alaska airports

The state is moving ahead with airport improvement projects for Sleetmute and Crooked Creek, according to the July issue of *The Kuskokwim Drift*.

Installation of airport lights and an air navigation facility at Sleetmute could begin this fall and is scheduled for completion in 1988.

The navigation facility will be constructed on corporation land, for which an easement was issued to the state. Lighting will be installed along the new runway, built on land conveyed to the state for airport purposes.

The Crooked Creek airport improvements will likely begin in 1988 and will consist of lengthening, widening and resurfacing the existing airstrip.
