14 Scholarships

Scholarships for 14 Indian students will be made available at the University of Georgia for secondary social science education next fall.

The program, contingent upon the award of a contract by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, provides scholarships of \$3,600 for a 12 month period. Trainees will pay tuition and other expenses from their award.

To apply students must have completed the sophomore year of college. Those finishing their junior year in good standing will be eligible for reappointment. A two year commitment must be made to the program and applicants should have a desire to make Indian education a career.
