Loyette Goodell, Executive director of Alaska Legal Services announced that the Lilly Endowment, Inc. of Indianapolis, Indiana has approved a grant in the amount of \$66,800 to the Alaska Legal Services Corporation. The grant year is April, 1977 through March, 1978. The purpose of the grant is for support of the Alaska Native Law Unit to assist Alaska Legal Services bush law offices deliver legal assistance to people of rural Alaska.
