

8 Alaskans Appointed Postmasters

The appointment of eight Alaskan postmasters was announced last week in Seattle under a new non-political merit system authorized by the postal reorganization act.

Fred Huleen, Seattle Regional Director for the U.S. Postal Service, announced the appointments, effective immediately.

Under the new plan, a Regional Management Selection Board reviews the qualifications of applicants and makes its recommendations to the Postmaster General.
