


3. SUBSISTENCE CAMPSITE - To qualify, you must show that you used a campsile in 1971 for subsistence activities, that only you or your family used the land, that there were improvements such as fish racks, tentframes, etc., on the land and that you needed subsistence activities for a large portion of your food and other livelihood. (this is not a Native Allotment)

4. REINDEER HUSBANDRY HEADQUARTER SITE - To qualify, you must show that you conducted reindeer herding activities in 1971 on the land you are claiming and that there were structures such as corrais or storage sheds on the land in 1971.

5. LAND FOR NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION - To qualify, organizations must show that they are legally established non-profit organizations, that they used the land for a large portion of 1971 and that there were im-provements or buildings on the land.

LAND GIVEN TO APPLICANTS FOR THE USES DISCRIBED IN NUMBERS 1, 2 and 5 WILL BE THE SIZE OF AN AVERAGE VILLAGE LOT, OR 80' X 120' WHICHEVER IS SMALLER IN SIZE. SUBSISTENCE CAMPSITES WILL BE NO LARGER THAN 150' X 150' FEET, REINDEER SITES WILL BE LIMITED TO THREE (3) ACRES.
