## NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE DIVISION OF ELECTIONS OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR

Notice is given that the division of elections, under authority vested in AS 15.10.020 and AS 15.15.010, proposes to adopt regulations in Title 6 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with precinct boundary changes and the administration of state, local and regional elections to implement, interpret and make specific, certain provisions of Title 4, Title 14, Title 15 and Title 29 of the Alaska Statutes, as follows:

Notice is also given that any interested person may receive copies of the proposed regulation from any office of the Division of Elections in Anchorage, Fairbanks, Nome or Juneau.

Any interested person may present written statements or arguments relative to the proposed action by writing to the Director of the Division of Elections at P.O. Box AF, Juneau, Alaska 99811-0105, so that they are received no later than the close of business May 22, 1987.

This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation.

The division of Elections, upon its own motion or at the instance of any interested person, may, after the deadline stated above, adopt proposals within the scope of this notice without further notice, or may decide to take no action on them.
