The program to provide legal aid to the poor and poverty stricken throughout the State of Alaska is a program that must proceed on a statewide basis now, either with or without the Alaska Bar Association.

The present catastrophic situation demands immediate attention and solution by legislators, ASCAP, and the Alaska Bar Association. The alternatives are:

1. Placement of the program under the new Department of Native Affairs.
2. Legislative endorsement of ASCAP to run the program itself, or
3. A salvaging of the present cooperative program operated by ASCAP and the legal profession.
