

Mather elected Doyon Chairman

Rosemarie Maher of Northway was elected Chairman of the Doyon Board of Directors at the board meeting held March 15 immediately following the 1986 Annual Meeting of Shareholders. Maher replaced Sam Demientieff who has served as Chairman for the past three years. Demientieff's term as Doyon Board member continues until 1988.

First elected to the Doyon Board in 1979, Maher has served as Corporate Secretary since 1981. She also serves on various committees of the Board, including Search and Compensation, Lands and Resources, and Investments.

Besides her many years of service to Doyon, Limited, Maher has had extensive involvement at the village, subregional and regional levels. Since 1975 she has been President of Northway Natives, Inc., the village corporation for Northway, and President of its subsidiary, Naabia Niign, Ltd. Maher is married and is the mother of four children. In a related action, the Board elected Georgianna Lincoln as Secretary, the officer position left vacant when Maher was elected Chairman. Michael Harper continues as Treasurer.
