

Betty McCallum Plans Wedding

Romance, and federal Health, Education and Welfare Department regulations clashed head on last week in the Head Start Staff at RurAL CAP, when Betty McCallum, Director of Child Development, and Howard Scaman, Deputy Director of the same program, set a July 10th date for their wedding at First Methodist Church in Anchorage.
