

Young Africans to Come to Juneau

Senator Ted Stevens has announced that a group of young African leaders will visit Juneau, Alaska, in mid-July to acquaint themselves with Alaska's progress and politics during its first decade of statehood.

The visit is sponsored by the State Department's Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs. Representatives from Botswana, Nigeria and Ethiopia will meet with Governor Keith Miller on July 16, 1970.

The group will be accompanied by Ken Starr of the African-American Institute.
