

Galena's runway is repaired

Repair of the runway at Galena by means of an asphaltic overlay has been completed. Central Construction, contracted by the Alaska District, Corps of Engineers for the project, is cleaning up the area and stockpiling equipment for the winter.

The work was necessary to overcome rapid deterioration of this facility. The Air Force, funding source for the runway, took beneficial occupancy during September 1974.

Approximately 5,400 tons of asphaltic concrete have been placed on the north and south halves of the runway.

Galena Airport, a state property, is used by private and commercial flyers in addition to the Air Force.
