

Native Youth Olympics on April 2 in Anchorage

Over 150 students from across the state will be in Anchorage this weekend to take part in the 7th Annual Native Youth Olympics.

According to Frank Charles of Cook Inlet Native Association (CINA) who sponsors the Olympics, CINA will be sponsoring two students from each high school in the state to attend the competition.

Events for the one-day finals will include: One Foot High Kick; Two Foot High Kick; Head Pull; Leg Wrestling; Seal Hop; Toe Kick; Stick Pull; and Kneel Jump.

The team representing secondary students from Nome took first place for team standings in the 1976 Olympics, followed closely by students representing the Bethel area.

This years competition will be held Saturday, April 2 at the City Gymnasium beginning at 8:00 AM.
