

EDUCATIONAL SERVICES:

COLLEGE COURSES

To enroll in an instructional TV course for college credit, contact your regional community college or rural education center. Credit and the necessary print course materials (textbooks, workbooks) will be supplied by the local sponsoring UA unit participating in each course.

CHILDREN'S INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMMING:

Elementary and secondary instructional TV programs are scheduled daily, Monday through Friday, for in-class use or taping for later classroom use. These ITV programs are accompanied by print teacher guides, to assist lesson planning and use of these programs in school.

The January issue of the LEARN/ALASKA Magazine contains a full catalog of these children's ITV programs and the complete daytime schedule. Copies are distributed to all school principals.
