Sunny Jim. It's the good word in sandwiches.



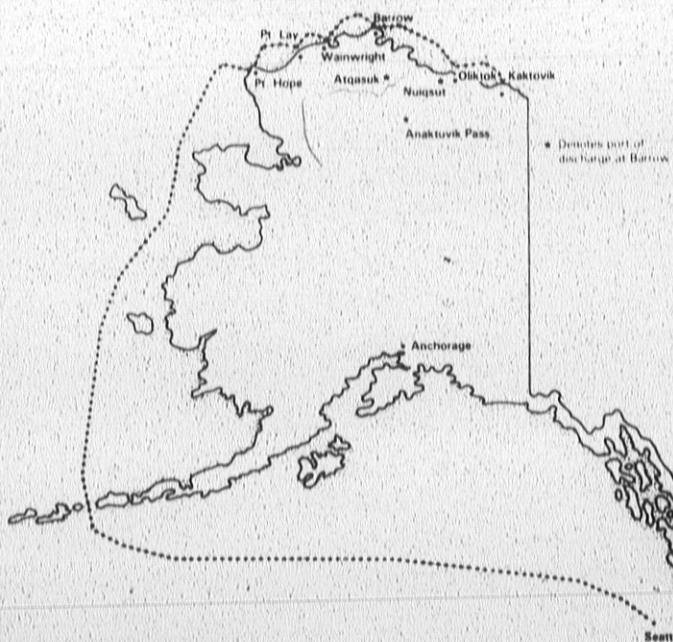
Recognize This Symbol?
