UA News Director Davies Passes

Lawrence E. Davies, director of the University of Alaska News Service and veteran New York Times newsman died Friday night after a heart attack at his home on the university campus. He was 71

On the evening he died, Davies was scheduled to attend a party run by the Tundra Times at the home of UA assistant professor Ron Senungetuk. Davies had been with the university since August 1970 when he assumed the post of news service director. He lived on the UA campus with his wife and granddaughter.

The veteran newsman retired from the New York Times in March of 1970 after 44 years with the paper in New York, Philadelphia and San Francisco.
