

Signup for Exhibitors at Sealaska Fair

Exhibitor signup for the May 13-23 Sealaska Travel and Trade Fair in Seattle has neared 50 and is still continuing, it was reported today.

The 11-day celebration will bring the color and excitement of Alaska and the Yukon Territory to the Seattle Center.

Included among the 48 exhibitors announced by Seattle Center Coordinator Louis Larsen and by Alaska In-State Coordinator Larry Beck, representing Alaska Travel Division, are more than a dozen cities and travel-oriented government agencies.

Representatives are expected from Fairbanks, Anchorage, Ketchikan, Juneau, Valdez, Homer and Soldotna, Seward, Haines, Palmer (with Mat-Su Borough), Kodiak, Metlakatla, Sitka, and Nome. Also represented will be the Travel Division of the State of Alaska Department of Economic Development, Alaska Marine Highway System, Yukon Territory, U.S. Forest Service, and the National Park Service.

In addition, Larsen and Beck listed many additional exhibitors representing airlines, tour companies, tourist-oriented businesses, publications, and other areas of interest.
