

BIA Village Flood Plans

John Doore, representative of the Alaska Disaster Office in Anchorage, left today with a social worker from the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) to discuss flood plans at Stevens Village, Koyukuk and Galena.

"These are the only villages we're worried about at the moment in the Fairbanks area," said Wallace Craig, head of the Fairbanks BIA.

Later Doore hopes to meet with Lou Hanks of the University of Alaska to check villages in the Bethel area. They will discuss evacuation plans and the surest communication links to alert villages in advance of high water.
