

REAA workshop features Leo Marks

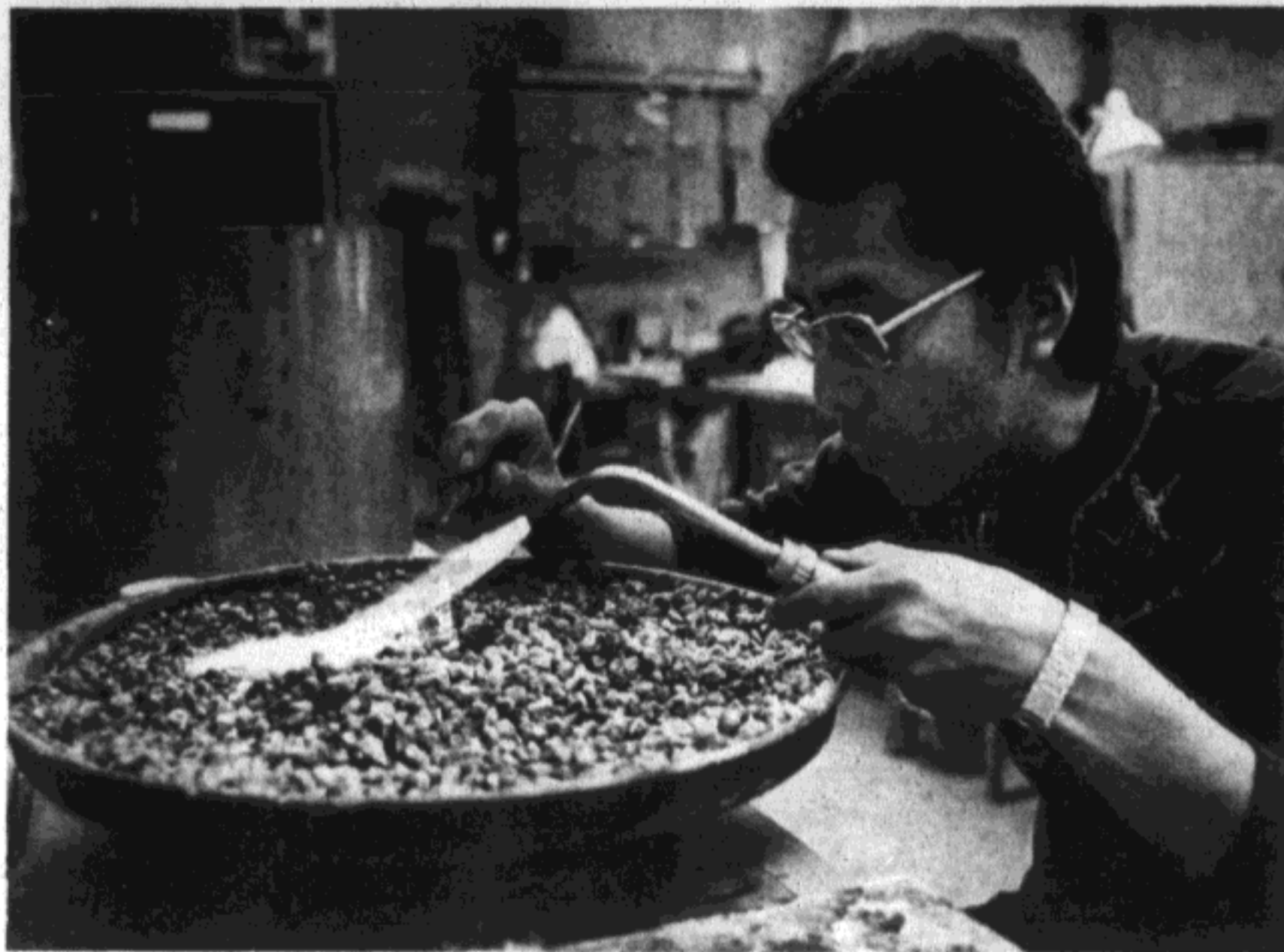
The Village Art Program of Rural Educational Affairs, UAA Fairbanks, will sponsor a workshop on metal crafting of bronze May 16 through June 3. Instructor Leo Marks, will feature instruction on the layered technique of soldering.

Mr. Marks' diverse background as a dancer and singer with the Mark's Trail Tlingit Indian Dancers, a silversmith, an instructor of wood carving and a student of Ron Senungetuk's silver-smithing course at the university, all serve to enhance his ability as an instructor of various Alaskan art works.

The workshop will be offered Monday through Friday, May 16th to June 3rd, during the evenings from 7 - 9 p.m. Additional workshop time may be scheduled during the day. The course is tuition free, but students will be paying for supplies as necessary.
