

BLM Gears for Claims Work

BLM's Fairbanks District is actively gearing to meet the requirements of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act enacted by the Congress on December 18, 1971. According to Richard H. LeDosquet, BLM District and Land Office Manager.

Approximately 30 new employees will be brought on board in the near future the manager stated today.

The oncoming personnel are specialists in various fields relating to lands and resources, and will be directly involved in expediting the carrying out of the Bureau's role as set forth in the Native Claims Act.

To provide working quarters for the expanding staff the Bureau of Land Management has requested the General Services Administration to look for additional office space in the Fairbanks area.

Although most of the new BLM employees will be based in Fairbanks, Native Claims work will be carried on throughout the Fairbanks BLM District, LeDosquet said.

Moves to Stop Bogus Indian Arts

The Attorney General of Arizona has issued an injunction ordering trading posts in that state to halt the sale of "Indian" beadwork, rugs, jewelry, dolls and baskets which reportedly are manufactured in Japan and Mexico.

The injunction came after state investigators raided six shops along Route 66 in upstate Arizona and found as much as 95 percent of the goods to be imported.

The Attorney General's office says its investigators can prove that merchants have falsely passed off the crafts as "authentic Indian wares" and that foreign manufacturing labels have been removed by shopkeepers, resulting in "tremendous losses" to authentic Indian artisans.

Rights Commission Meeting Here

ANCHORAGE — It was announced from Anchorage that the five-member Board of Commissioners to the Alaska Human Rights Commission will meet in Fairbanks on June 14 through 16.

The meeting will begin at 10:00 a.m. in the Conference Room of the Fairbanks Native Welcome Center on Wednesday and it will be open to the public.

The Board will hear reports from Executive Director Robert Willard which will include his recommendations on an order to finalize an age discrimination case against another state agency which the Board has already ruled on, but the decision has never been made public.

Willard will also report on the latest Alaska Native, Black and other minority-hire statistics employed by the state government and the current status of the Alaska Plan.

Other topics include a model ordinance for presentation to city's and borough's for their consideration to establish Human Relations Commissions on a local level, along with other items of interest.

The Commission will allow individuals or groups to appear in person during the three day meeting.
