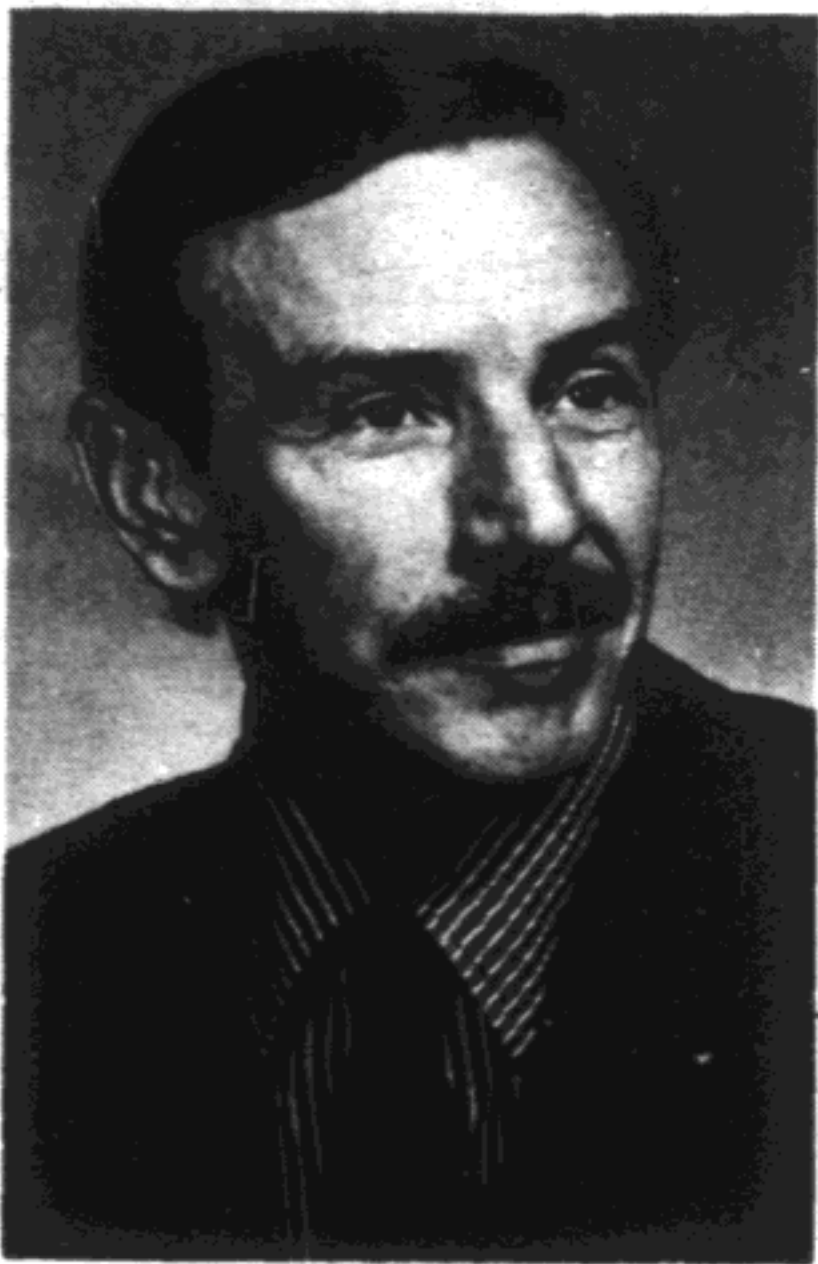


Planning Firm Installs Bob Arnold as Officer
