For Barrow— Manpower Center

JUNEAU—The Department of Labor will construct a permanent building to house its Barrow Manpower Center, Governor Keith H. Miller reported.

According to the Governor, the center has been using space donated by the Barrow City Council since it opened in June 1969. The new office is expected to be completed by June 1.

Miller said the Department of Public Work's Division of Buildings will be in charge of the project, and local labor will be hired to erect the \$27,500 structure. It will be financed through the Department of Labor's Training and Building Fund.

The Barrow Manpower Center is a suboffice of the Fairbanks Manpower Center. Arthur Panigeo is the manager.
