

# TCC to hold Classes on Jobs

The Tanana Chiefs Conference Employment Division will be conducting classes for all interested people on "How to Get and Keep Local Jobs," starting Oct. 3.

The classes will be scheduled through the Employment Division at T.C.C. and will include: How to fill out applications; interviews with employers; where to find jobs in the local Fairbanks job Market; child care problems--ideas on solving them; Preparing your family for your working outside the home; budgets and how they can work for you.

While the classes are being aimed mainly toward the homemaker and women who have not had much experience with working outside the home, anyone is welcome to attend under the Tanana Chiefs Conference Employment Division area.

With the pipeline employment jobs few and far between, the young people and women will be able to fill the impact of jobless heads of the households by taking local jobs that pay less than pipeline wages, but that are available and permanent.
