

Sitka marine mammal regs are available for review

The Sitka Marine Mammal Commission has gathered proposed regulations for the arrangement of sea otter populations within the customary and traditional territory of the Sitka Tribe. These regulations do not set harvest limits, but there are areas proposed to be closed to hunting. Copies of the proposed regulations are available at the of-

fices of the local IRA tribal governments, local post offices, and the local offices of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and the Alaska Department of Fish and Game.
