women's conference

The Alaska Commission on the Status of Women announced that it will provide travel assistance grants to people interested in attending the March statewide women's conference, "Alaska's Women: Dete-mining Our Futures" in Anchorage.

There are funds for approximately 50 grants and because the commission wants to help as many women as possible, travel assistance is limited to 50 percent of your total round-trip airfare or \$300, whichever is the lesser amount.

A conference advisory committee will evaluate requests for travel assistance using the following criteria:

(1) applicant's prior attendance at a commission-sponsored regional women's conference;

(2) applicant's desire to participate in planning a regional

women's conference in her area; (3) indication of applicant's intention to report the activities and results of this statewide conference to her community; and (4) applicant's geographical location, i.e., the committee will attempt to have broad statewide representation. The distance to be traveled will be considered.
