

# *'Foster Homes' Available for Village Students*

High school age students turned down from the BIA's Mt. Edgecumbe school because of over-crowded conditions can apply for a "foster home" in Fairbanks to attend school.

They should either write directly to the Department of Education in Juneau, or call 452-1245 in Fairbanks, the number of the BIA's education office here.

An attempt is being made here to find foster homes for rural youngsters in Fairbanks and Anchorage. A special fund to provide board and room in homes for 100 youngsters has been made available from the State Department of Education.

In Fairbanks, local citizens are trying to find homes for 30 rural students turned down from Mt. Edgecumbe.

Room for fifty students will be located in Anchorage, with the rest to be placed in Dillingham.
