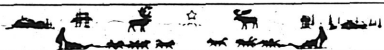
AIDA will purchase the guaranteed portion of your new SBA Loan from your Lender, making these funds available to you at the lowest rate currently offered.

The AIDA rate changes monthly according to the Bond Market, but is a fixed rate for the term of the loan.
